

Government Clauses – Fixed Priced, Labor Hour and Time and Material Orders for Commercial or COTS Supplies and Services

PURCH-2001

These terms apply to orders for items or services that have been confirmed by Buyer to meet the definition presented in FAR 2.101 of “Commercial” or “COTS”. The listed FAR and DFARS clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in full text. Clauses shall be interpreted to reflect the relationship between the Buyer and Seller. Where necessary to derive proper meaning from these clauses, “Contractor” means “Seller,” “Contracting Officer” means “Buyer,” “Contract” means this Order and “Government” means “Buyer or the Government.” The words “Government” and “Contracting Officer” do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the prime contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative, and (2) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the government.

Seller agrees that upon the request of Buyer it will negotiate in good faith with Buyer relative to amendments to this Order to incorporate additional provisions herein or to change provisions hereof, as Buyer may reasonably deem necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the applicable Prime Contractor with the provisions of amendments to such Prime Contract. If any such amendment to this Order causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, performance of any part of the Work under this Order, an equitable adjustment shall be made pursuant to the "Changes" clause of this Contract.
